DEPLETION OF WELL-WATER



Fracking uses thousands of litres of water per well—water that our communities and ecosystems depend on.

- Low water levels in wells and streams
- Stress on aquifers during droughts
- Long-term strain on our water supply



CONTAMINATION OF WELL-WATER



Fracking threatens the safety of our drinking water.

- Chemicals used in fracking can leak or spill
- Risk of contamination to wells, rivers and wetlands
- Once contaminated, water can't be made safe

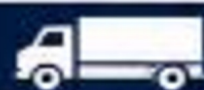


HEALTH IMPACTS



Fracking has been linked to serious health problems.

- Respiratory issues (asthma, coughing, wheezing)
- Headaches, nausea, fatigue
- Increased risk of cancer and other chronic illnesses
- Impacts on children, seniors and vulnerable people



IMPACTS FROM TRANSPORTATION (TRUCKS) AND ROADS

- Hundreds of heavy truck trips per day on our local roads
- Road damage, potholes, and higher maintenance costs
- Dust, noise, and air pollution affect our quality of life
- Higher risk of accidents, spills and dangerous materials transported through our communities
